Parish or neighborhood based groups of 5-10 job seekers who agree

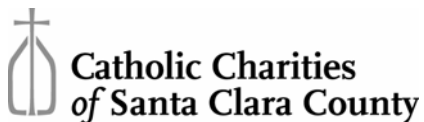
- to focus, support, and encourage each other
